### **Le Grand Bornand**

FOR AVENTURE: Le Grand-Bornand has 160 km of signposted hiking trails, including a climb up the impressive Pointe Percée, overlooking the Aravis range from an altitude of 2700m, some famous climbing routes and a via-ferrata. For cycling, the resort has featured 8 times in the Tour de France since 1995 and can boast the fearsome ascent of the Col de la Colombière, a top site on the Route des Grandes Alpes tourist itinerary, plus 102 km of mountain-bike trails in the Alpine pastures

FOR ITS BOHEMIAN SPIRIT: With just over forty farms producing the famous farmhouse reblochon cheese, craftspeople with workshops in some of the oldest chalets in the resort, and over 400 chalets two-century-old chalets (a record), the surprising Cow Art trail bringing colour to the streets and banks of the River Borne, an attractive mountain stream where you can dip your feet after a walk, Le Grand-Bornand is always a delight for bohemian spirits. Unless you prefer the bustling atmosphere of «La Source» with its nature and culture workshops, or the poetry of a picnic at sunset on the banks of the Lac de la Cour.

FOR ITS EPICUREAN SPIRIT: The top-quality restaurants serving the best in local gastronomy based on short food-supply chains are a welldeserved reward after an intense golfing session on the 10-hole course. Or you might prefer to get back into focus with a spot of open-air yoga in the company of one of the village's qualified instructors

# Val d'Isère

In summer, the traditional village of Val d'Isère surrounded by the Vanoise National Park and accessible via the legendary Iseran Pass offers all kinds of adventure. The Bike Park adapted to different disciplines, including the increasingly popular electric biking, attracts biking lovers of all levels. From 29 to 31 July the E-Bike Festival offers an opportunity to try the latest e-biking equipment. Families enjoy relaxing picnics at the Ouillette lake, gentle walks through Val d'Isère forests and a rich selection of cultural and sports activities.

## **Les Menuires**

Located between 1,200 and 3,200 meters above sea level, the Vallée des Belleville, with its flower-filled meadows rising up to snow-capped peaks, will broaden your horizons: go back to basics and explore all facets of mountain life here, from the authentic village of Saint Martin de Belleville, to the lakes of Les Menuires, the green meadows give way to the blue of the glaciers, and the peaks of Val Thorens. New place to be for mountain biker: With more than 30 signposted mountain bike itineraries representing a total of nearly 260 km of routes, the Vallée des Belleville appears as an exceptional playground for all cycling enthusiasts! To help people discover the pleasures of downhill cycling, the valley's resorts, with Les Menuires in the lead, are multiplying initiatives and facilities for beginners, especially the youngest (ludizone, kid zone, pump track etc).
