Signature Experiences

- **Musée Grévin**: Kids and adults alike are sure to enjoy their time at the Musée Grévin that is home to over 200 wax celebrities from all walks of life!
- **Seine River Cruises**: Enjoy Paris's iconic landmarks on a sightseeing, lunch or dinner cruise aboard the Bateaux Mouches or the Bateaux Parisiens that also offers cruises for children.
- **Disneyland Paris**: Enjoy magical moments together with the family at Disneyland Paris and explore its 2 Disney Parks that have over 50 amazing attractions.
- **Parc Astérix**: Enjoy a thrilling day out at the Parc Astérix theme park, and create memories with your family.

Offbeat Experiences

- Enjoy a virtual bird's eye view of Parisian monuments with a jet pack at Fly View Paris.
- Sign up for a cooking class with your child at renowned chef Alain Ducasse's Ecole de Cuisine or Le Cordon Bleu. Kids can also enjoy a chocolate making experience at the Musée du Chocolat
- An educational awaits at the **Palais de Découverte** where kids and adults can take place in scientific demonstrations
- Parisian gardens such as the **Parc de la Villete**, **the Jardin des Tuilieries**, **le Jardin du Luxembourg** and the **Jardin d'Acclimatation** are ideal for those who love their green spaces and picnics. Kids can expect plenty of entertainment in the form of outdoor activities, rides and attractions.
- Museums can be fun too! The **Louvre Museum** organises workshops, storytelling sessions and actor led performance tours that make for a fun discovery of the museum's treasures
- Enjoy a safe indoor skydiving experience at IFIy Paris in the Vill'Up Shopping Centre.
- Picnics « à la parisienne » can also be enjoyed alongside the banks of the Seine, the Canal St Martin, le Parc des Buttes-Chaumont, the Parc Monceau to name a few popular locations.



CHAMPAGNE & ALSACE



Located less than an hour away from Paris by train, **Champagne** is home to the most iconic beverage in the world – *champagne*. Classified as UNESCO World Heritage, it is the only region in the world to produce the bubbly. Must-see in CHAMPAGNE & ALSACE

REIMS

Must see attractions in Reims include:

- The UNESCO Heritage Sites of the Notre-Dame Cathedral, The Tau Palace and Saint Remi Basilica.
- Discover the secrets of champagne making at prestigious champagne houses such as Pommery, Mumm, Ruinart
- Take to the skies on a hot air balloon ride over Reims and its surroundings for exquisite views over the famous Champagne Tourist Route or the Montagne de Reims Nature Park.
- Visit the Musée Automobiles in Reims which is home to 200 models of cars from throughout the 20th century and also 5000 different miniature car models from different eras.
- Visit the Terraltitude Adventure Park home to zip lining, bungee jumping and many other adventure sports for kids in complete safety.
- Enjoy a truffle hunting adventure with specially trained truffle-dogs at the Auberge des Moissons in Matougues

EPERNAY

Must see attractions in Epernay include:

- 'Avenue of Champagne' which has prestigious champagne houses such as Moet & Chandon, Mercier, Pierre Jouet and local champagne houses like Michel Gonet...
- Take a hot-air ride on the static Ballon d'Epernay for panoramic views of the hidden gardens of the Avenue de Champagne and the surrounding countryside.
- Discover the vineyards of Epernay on tuk-tuks, 4x4 or even vintage 2CV Citroens. Visit the family friendly Mercier vineyard which has a toy train running through 18 km of estate sure to amuse the little ones.
- Enjoy water sports at the Lac du Der Fun Centre such as kayaking, paddle boating and much more.

STRASBOURG

Begin your discovery of Strasbourg with:

- Notre-Dame Cathedral gem of Gothic art with the famous Astronomical Clock, the Place du Château
- Enjoy a boat ride of Strasbourg with Batorama that has an audio commentary created just for kids
- Discover the Petite France and the Covered Bridges of Strasbourg on board a mini train
- Explore the Orangerie Park that has a zoo, a mini farm, a vintage car track and several playgrounds for kids.
- Spend a day at the EuropaPark the 2nd most visited amusement park in Europe and located at an hours distance from Strasbourg or visit the Ecomusée an outdoor history museum.

Top experiences in Lyon

- Basillica of Notre Dame de Fourvière: for panoramic views of the city. A discovery of the traboules or covered passageways of Old Lyon. Visit of the Croix-Rousse district known for its silk products and silk workshops.
- The Musée des Confluences that explains the origin of mankind
- Enjoy a Sunday brunch and shop for some of the best local specialities at the famed covered market dedicated to gastronomy -Les Halles de Lyon by Paul Bocuse.
- Musée Lumière- learn more about the origins of cinema at the home of the Lumière brothers who shot the world's first motion picture.
- Visit the Tête D'Or Park that is home to a zoological park, a botanical garden in spring and pony rides and miniature golf for the little ones.

Top Experiences in the French Riviera

NICE

- Discover Nice's popular attractions through the charming tourist train or through the Cyclopolitain, an electric tricycle.
- Visit Cours Saleya, a colourful open-air market well-known for food and flowers
- Choose between 15 private and 20 public beaches. While *Miami Beach* is a hotspot for families, water sports enthusiasts can head to the *Blue Beach* for a slew of aquatic activities.
- Visit the Castle Hill for its waterfall, picnic and playground area for kids.
- The Promenade Paillon is perfect for families with its large mirror fountain, playground and jungle gym.
- Visit the Cimiez neighbourhood in Old Nice for a picnic or for discovering the Roman Amphitheatre and the Monastery Gardens that offer stunning views of Nice.

CANNES

- Enjoy a walk along the Croisette for magnificent views of the bay and its public beaches. Keep an eye out for the Murs peints that depict Cannes famous street art.
- Outside the Palais des Festivals, home to the International Film Festival, feel starry eyed on a walk along the Path of Stars.
- Visit Le Suquet known as the birthplace of Cannes and a picturesque old quarter. Enjoy a visit of the Forville market that showcases local produce. A 2-hour guided gourmet tour will have you relishing 8 different tastings during your walk around the stalls.
- Discover the Lérin Islands of Sainte-Marguerite and Saint-Honorat by boat or by helicopter. Include visits to the Royal Fort, the Sea Museum and the abbey of Lérin during your time here.
- Discover Cannes on a helicopter that takes you around the Lérin Islands and the Esterel Massif
- Discover the medieval village of Gourdon or the old town of Antibes or embark on excursions to medieval villages such as Eze, Saint-Paul de Vence, Menton and Grasse.
